







Asbestos In Materials (AIMS) Scheme


Round 47 of AIMS was completed on 1st June 2012. In total, 251 laboratories participated in the round and there were 176 (70%) UK laboratories and 75 (30%) Non-UK laboratories. 231 (92% of total AIMS participants) laboratories have participated in enough rounds (according to the scheme protocol) to obtain a cumulative score (3 month rolling score). Following the validation process, round 47 was judged to be of standard complexity and suitability, with a range of sample types including two of the four samples that were commercially produced/imported and would be seen from time to time in routine analytical jobs.

1. Types of Errors Obtained

Chart 1: AIMS Round 47 Sample Errors



False Negative = Component has been missed.
False Positive = Component has been incorrectly identified as present.

2. Round Scores

Chart 2 illustrates the distribution of scores for all participating laboratories. 221 (88%) of laboratories obtained a score of zero in this round, indicating that these laboratories had not made any errors. The distribution of scores obtained by UK (United Kingdom) and Non-UK laboratories is also compared; 166 (94%) UK laboratories and 55 (73%) Non-UK laboratories obtained a score of zero for the round.

Chart 2: Distribution & Comparison of Errors AIMS Round 47




Chart 3 shows the percentage distribution of cumulative 3 round scores for all laboratories, UK and Non-UK. 9% (20 laboratories) in total had not yet completed 3 rounds and therefore did not accumulate a score; these laboratories are not represented in the chart. Following this round (47), 7 laboratories (3%) in total obtained an unsatisfactory score (ie more than 39 penalty points cumulatively) after participating in 3 rounds. Whilst the number of laboratories having an unsatisfactory score is relatively low there are currently 26 laboratories with scores between 8 – 20, and 5 laboratories with scores between 21 – 39.






Chart 3: Distribution & Comparison of Cumulative Scores Following AIMS Round 47
